Eighth Grade Parents – Student Academic & Career Plans

Eighth grade students recently met with school counselors to develop their Academic and Career Plan, (ACP). The ACP is a tentative plan for high school courses, developed by each student based on graduation requirements, individual student interests and academic progress. The ACP is not students' registration for high school classes; the ACP is a planning document.

Each parent/guardian will receive an email from *Major Clarity*, which will provide access to their student's ACP. The subject of the email from *Major Clarity* will be: *Your Student's Academic Report*. There will be a link in the email that will provide access to your student's Academic and Career Plan (ACP). After reviewing your child's ACP, please take a moment to acknowledge receipt of the guiding document (electronic signature).

Please be aware that the ACP is a planning document, and it will likely change as your student progresses through high school.

Each student has a login and password to access the *Major Clarity* website, which contains information about careers and colleges.
