ASBESTOS MANAGEMENT, OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE PLAN

This Asbestos Management Operations and Maintenance Plan is based on the Three (3) Year AHERA Reinspection performed by Baratta & Associates, Inc. on October 6, 2008. It covers procedures to be followed in dealing with the Asbestos-Containing Materials (ACMs) found in Northside High School.

SUMMARY

All ACMs discovered during the 1988 inspection have been removed. No ACMs were found during the 2008 reinspecton.

RECOMMENDED ASBESTOS RELATED PROCEDURES

We believe that no ACMs exist in the Northside High School Building. However, additional suspect asbestos containing materials may be hidden behind the walls, ceilings and other concealed spaces. Therefore, should suspect materials be encountered they should be sampled and tested for asbestos mineral content. The results of these tests will dictate what, if any, response actions are applicable.

No other asbestos related procedures are present at this time.
