



Health, Physical Education and Driver Education Summer School 2019

Summer school Health and PE 9 and 10 courses are taught in a full-credit format. Separate health and PE semester options are not available. The condensed nature of these courses is physically demanding and students who enroll will be expected to participate fully in all activities each day. There will be no consideration for pre-excused absences. As you consider summer school enrollment, keep in mind the eight period block schedule provides ample opportunity for most students to take both of the required HPE courses during the regular school year and still have room for additional electives.

*Please note that the dates and times outlined below are unique to the Health and PE courses are not consistent with other summer school programs.

Health and PE 9

The physical education component of this course will be offered at Northside High School, June 10 – June 26, Monday – Friday, from 8 am – 2:05 pm.

The health component will be completed online with course work provided via Blackboard. Students may begin work on the health content June 10 and the course will end on July 9.

The cost of the course will be \$400 (\$350 for the cost of tuition plus \$50 to cover the cost of field trips that are part of the course). Payment to be made at time of registration.

Registration may be done through the School Counseling Department at all secondary schools
May 13 - 24.

Health and PE 10

The physical education component of this course will be offered at Northside High School, June 10 – June 26, Monday – Friday, from 8 am – 2:05 pm.

The health component will be a combination of face to face and online instruction. Students will be required to attend class June 27- July 3 from 8 am – 3:00 pm at Northside High School to satisfy the requirements for classroom driver education. The remainder of the health curriculum will be taught online via Blackboard. Students may begin work on the health content June 10 and the course will end July 9.

The cost of the course will be \$400 (\$350 for the cost of tuition plus \$50 to cover the cost of field trips that are part of the course). Payment to be made at time of registration.

May 13 - May 24.

Driver Education: Behind-the-Wheel

Behind-the-Wheel instruction will be offered this summer to those students who have a learner's permit and have successfully completed the classroom component of driver education by June 1. The course requires fourteen hours of instruction over seven days. All instruction will take place between June 10 and July 12 at Northside High School. The cost of this program is \$200 and enrollment is limited. Complete details and registration information will be posted on the RCPS Summer School page by April 2.
