

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT

ATTENDANCE AND CONDUCT

Students must report on the first day they are notified and attend every day of summer school. If an absence or a tardy occurs, all time and work missed must be made up beginning on the day of return.

Students must stay on the day they return to make up missed time. A note from a parent/guardian is required on all absences and tardies. Medical or other appointments should be made after school hours or on the days school is closed. The last day of summer school is set aside for final exams and final activities. All work must be completed by that day. Students will not be excused on the last day of summer school. No exams will be given early.

Edgenuity students may be asked to give up their seat and return at a later date due to persistent tardies and or absences.

Students who are absent in excess of one (1) day will be withdrawn from summer school with No Refund. A final grade of "F" will be given. Students who fail to make up all time makeup time owed will earn an "F" for the course.

Two (2) violations of discipline, one (1) serious infraction of the Conduct Code or skipping class may lead to dismissal from summer school with No Refund. A final grade of "F" will be given. Students will be governed by the Roanoke County Public Schools Conduct Code.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins on May 13, 2019 and ends at 4:00 pm on May 24, 2019. All registration forms and payment must be received by the May 24 deadline.

TRANSPORTATION

No transportation will be provided by Roanoke County. Transportation will be the responsibility of the student and parent.

2019 Summer School Session will be held at Northside High School.

PROGRAM

Face-to-face courses will be taught only if enrollment is sufficient. Consideration can be given to seniors who need a repeat class. Students may register for a repeat course only if they have been previously enrolled in the course for its duration.

Courses for which there is not sufficient enrollment to offer a face-to-face class in traditional classroom environment may be provided through Edgenuity, an online, individualized program of study with assistance from certified RCPS teachers.

GRADE REPORTING

Final grades for both sessions will be mailed in July.

SCHEDULE

Repeat courses will be offered in a block schedule format.

*Session A (AM)	June 10-July 9	8:00AM-11:45AM
*Session B (PM)	June 10-July 9	12:15PM-4:00PM

***Classes will operate on a 5 day schedule. Classes will be held on Fridays. No classes will be held on July 4, or 5.**

***Students taking a course through Edgenuity online will be asked to make a session preference of AM or PM. All efforts will be made to accommodate preferences, but those who register first will have priority. Classes offered face-to-face will be scheduled based on the teacher availability.**

Schedule for all courses will be determined based on the student registration.

All students will be contacted prior to June 7 and informed of the session, date, and time they are to report. Students enrolled in Edgenuity courses will be called to begin their summer school course once a seat becomes available. Seats are based on the number of site licenses available to the division. Seniors will be given first priority. Once a student finishes, another student who is on the wait list will be contacted to report.

COURSE AVAILABILITY

Students not enrolled in Roanoke County Public Schools will be admitted on a space available basis. If a course is not offered or not available, students will be notified by June 7.

Health and PE 9*

The physical education component of this course will be offered at NHS, June 10 – June 26, Monday–Friday, from 8 am–2:05 pm. The health component will be completed online with course work provided via Blackboard. Students may begin work on the health content June 10 and the course will end on July 9. The cost of the course will be \$400 (\$350 for the cost of tuition plus \$50 to cover the cost of field trips that are part of the course). Registration may be done through the School Counseling Department at all secondary schools May 13 through May 24.

Health and PE 10*

The physical education component of this course will be offered at NHS, June 10– June 26, Monday–Friday, from 8 am–2:05 pm. The health component will be a combination of face to face and online instruction. Students will be required to attend class June 27 – July 3 from 8 am –3:00 pm at NHS to satisfy the requirements for classroom driver education. The remainder of the health curriculum will be offered online via Blackboard. Students may begin work on the health content June 10 and the course will end July 9. The cost of the course will be \$400 (\$350 for the cost of tuition plus \$50 to cover the cost of field trips that are part of the course). Registration may be done through the School Counseling Department at all secondary schools May 13 through May 24.

*Please note that the dates and times outlined above unique to the Health and PE courses are not consistent with other summer school programs.

Registration deadline is May 24, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.
